

NOTICE TO CONTRIBUTORS

The Journal of Aero Medical Society of India will be published annually by the Institute of Aviation Medicine, Bangalore-17. Papers submitted for publication and all other editorial communications should be addressed to the Editor. All contributors should certify that their papers have not been published elsewhere and that if accepted they will not be offered for publication elsewhere without the consent of the Editorial Board.

All papers should be typewritten in double spacing on one side of the paper only, with a two-inch margin. Illustrations should be separate from the type script, and numbered in sequence with appropriate legends on a separate sheet. The maximum size for any illustration is $5\frac{1}{2}$ by 8 inches. The author's name should be marked on the back of each, and the upper edge marked 'Top' for guidance in printing. Graphs and Charts should be drawn clearly in Indian ink on tracing linen or stout smooth white paper. Lettering should be either neatly written in Indian ink or lightly written in pencil. Photographs should be glossy. Photomicrographs should indicate the degree of magnification.

References should be listed alphabetically by the last name of the senior author and numbered. In the case of Journals, abbreviations should be listed according to the World List of Scientific Periodicals—volume number and the page number both written in arabic numerals, the former underlined to indicate bold type, followed by the year of publication, e.g.,

Johnson W. H., Stubbs R. A., Kelk G. F., and Franks W. R.:
Stimulus required to produce Motion Sickness. *J. Aviation Med.* 22:
365, October 1951.

When a book is referred to, the full title, edition, page of publication, publisher and year of publication, should be given, e.g.,

Armstrong, Harry G.: *Principle and Practice of Aviation Medicine*:
Ed. 3, Pp. 421-436. Baltimore: William and Wilkins Company, 1952

When Technical Reports are referred to, the names of the authors will be given followed by the full title, the abbreviated name of the report followed by its number, its place of issue and year, e.g.,

Cranell, C. W. and Cristensen, J. M.: Expansion of the Form Field by
Perimeter Training. WADC TR 55-368. Wright Air Development
Centre, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio. 1955.

References should be cited in the text by the appropriate number in accordance with alphabetically listed references, e.g.

Mukerjee, considers that.....
The view is held (Brown² Ghose⁵ Smith¹⁰)

Contributors will each receive 25 reprints free of cost.
