#### THE SEVENTH ANNUAL MEETING

For the first time the Annual Meeting of the Aero Medical Society was held at Bangalore from the 31st October to the 2nd November 1960. It was organized by H. Q. Training Command. The late Air Marshal S. Mukerjee inaugurated the Conference. It was presided over by the D. M. S. (Air), Air Cdre. B. L. Kapur. Among the distinguished invitees who attended, were Sir C. V. Raman, Air Marshal A. M. Engineer DFC, Air Vice Marshal Ranjan Dutt Vr. C., Major General S. P. Bhatia D.M.S. (Army) and Surgeon Cdre. A. K. Dev D.M.S. (Navy).
